I've watched too many brilliant Nigerian women waste years on men who were never going to marry them. Women with great careers, beautiful hearts, and everything going for them - except the right strategy for finding and keeping a man who's serious about marriage.

I'm Funmi Adeleke, and I've been exactly where you are. I spent my twenties dating the wrong men for the wrong reasons, wondering why relationships kept falling apart just when things seemed to be getting serious. The problem wasn't me, and it's not you either. The problem is that most dating advice completely ignores how Nigerian men actually think about relationships and marriage.

This book isn't about changing yourself to please a man. It's about understanding what serious Nigerian men are looking for, where to find them, and how to build the kind of relationship that naturally leads to marriage. You'll learn to spot the difference between a man who's just having fun and one who's genuinely ready to settle down.

### *READ THIS FIRST*

*The men worth marrying are not desperate. They have options. Your job isn't to chase them or convince them - it's to position yourself as the obvious choice when they're ready to commit.*

I'll be honest with you throughout this book. Some of what I share might challenge ideas you've held about dating and relationships. Some strategies require patience when you want quick results. But every technique in this guide has been tested by women who are now in happy marriages with men they genuinely respect and love.

You're not reading this book to become someone else. You're reading it to become the woman who attracts the right man and keeps him - authentically, confidently, and permanently.

## GETTING STARTED

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I've helped dozens of Nigerian women find lasting relationships, and I've seen the same patterns over and over again. The women who succeed aren't the prettiest or the richest - they're the ones who approach dating with clarity and strategy. This chapter will show you how to set yourself up properly before you even start looking.

Most women jump straight into dating apps or asking friends for introductions without doing the basic groundwork. That's like trying to build a house without a foundation. You'll waste months on the wrong men and wonder why nothing sticks.

### KNOW WHAT YOU ACTUALLY WANT

Before you talk to a single man, write down exactly what you're looking for. Not your dream list of "tall, rich, and handsome" - your real requirements.

I separate this into two categories: non-negotiables and preferences. Non-negotiables are deal-breakers. Mine include: wants marriage within 2 years, financially responsible, treats his family well, and shares my faith. Preferences are nice-to-haves like "works in tech" or "loves to travel."

Your non-negotiables list should have 4-6 items maximum. More than that and you're being unrealistic. Your preferences can be longer, but remember - preferences are things you can compromise on.

#### *REALITY CHECK*

*If you can't find 3 married women who found husbands meeting your standards, your standards might need adjusting.*

### FIX YOUR OWN FOUNDATION FIRST

The harsh truth? You can't attract a quality man if your own life is a mess. I'm not talking about being perfect - I'm talking about being stable and whole on your own.

Get your finances straight. You don't need to be rich, but you should be able to pay your own bills and have some savings. A man worth marrying wants a partner, not a dependent. If you're currently struggling financially, focus on that first before seriously dating.
