I started designing flyers for church events in Enugu using a cracked version of Photoshop CS3 on my uncle's laptop. I thought I was good. Then I moved to Lagos and tried to compete with real design agencies - and got crushed.

My problem wasn't talent. I could make things look decent. My problem was that I treated Photoshop like Microsoft Paint with layers. I didn't understand workflows, color modes, or how to create templates that clients could actually use. I spent hours on simple edits because I didn't know the shortcuts. Worse, my files were so disorganized that making client revisions meant starting over.

This book teaches you the Photoshop skills I wish I'd learned before losing my first three paying clients. You'll master the exact workflows, templates, and techniques that Nigerian design agencies use to charge NGN 150,000+ for brand packages while solo freelancers struggle to get NGN 15,000 for logos.

I've included 50+ ready-to-use client project templates - business cards, social media graphics, flyers, logos, and complete brand packages. But more importantly, I'll show you how to think like a professional designer, not just someone who knows where the tools are.

This isn't a beginner's guide to clicking around Photoshop. I assume you know what a layer is and can navigate the interface. This is about taking your existing skills and making them client-ready and profit-generating.
